Please plan to attend the Conservation Community Meeting on **Tuesday October 10 at 7pm** conducted by the City of Dallas Department of Development Services regarding the expansion of Vickery Place Conservation District.

The proposed expansion includes blocks: 5400 & 5500 Bonita, 5100, 5200, 5500 & 5600 Goodwin, 5200 & 5600 Miller, 5200 Richard, 5200 Vickery, and 5200, 5500, & 5600 Willis.

The purpose of the meeting is to provide an overview of the existing Vickery Place Conservation District ordinance. Those blocks appending onto the VPCD will assume these same standards. No architectural standards or guidelines will be negotiated at this meeting.

The CD ordinance only applies when you build a new home or do major renovation to the exterior of your existing home. It does *not* mean you will be forced to change your home or that you will be prohibited from doing so.

Just like the neighborhoods to our north and east, conservation status will protect our early 20th century architecture, maintain the scale, spacing and character of our homes, stabilize our community and increase neighborhood pride due to this recognition as a unique and special place!
